Basic visit to photograph the grave or memorial:	£25
Photographing the flowers from a funeral at 1 location:	From £45
A4 print in a 12" x 16" frame:	from £45
A3 print in 16" x 20" frame:	from £79
Card (strut) mount with photo up to 7" x 5":	£12
Card (strut) mount with photo up to 10" x 8":	£18
Other frames, such as a canvas wrap	Please ask for a quote
Incorporate other photographs for a montage	From £5 per photo
Placing of flowers / foliage for the photograph - these will be left on the grave or memorial	From £10

Other options include: albums, books and acrylic prints – please ask for a quotation.

There is a minimum order value (including visit cost) of £75 for the grave / memorial photography. These prices assume a normal burial plot with headstone and grass or stone surround or a crematorium garden with an accessible plaque.

These prices assume that the photography is undertaken at our convenience, but within an agreed time frame.

Charges include reasonable travel up to 10 driving miles from Aldeby (near Beccles) or 30 driving miles are included if £100 is spent. Longer distances are at 20p/mile.

Payment to be in £ sterling in cash or a cheque to be drawn on a UK bank (payable to PM Studios Ltd.).

Notes:

As regards our prices, photographers often find that people base the value of a photograph merely on the cost of a print in the local shops or the paper and ink to print it. But there is so much more that goes into producing lasting images for you and your family.

To get to this level of skill, Paul has spent time in education and training to learn the craft, over the years spent many hours practising his photography and editing the photographs. Additionally he has spent thousands of pounds on quality equipment to take the photographs, edit them on his computer and safely store the results.

Each image produced is the result of hours of preparation and work before, during and after the portrait session. It is these factors, not the material costs, that determines the prices.

Copyright:

Please note: as is the custom, and the legal status, copyright of the photographs remain with the photographer. Variation to these terms of use can be negotiated.

It is important for Paul to promote his business and his portfolio and that he is free to show his work to potential clients and others. Therefore, Paul retains the right to use the images for his portfolio of work which can be shown on websites, in print or for editorial uses etc. Paul will never display these images in a negative way nor use them for financial gain.

Copying prints or web images:

Please do not copy any print, CD or web image supplied by Paul. This is not permitted for two reasons: i) You are very unlikely to get the same quality of print from a copy – Paul does not want his work to be shown as substandard. ii) You are depriving Paul of income that allows him to run his business and get some return on the investment of both time and money that went into the making of the photograph in the first place.
